

Surrounded by Tourist Attractions

Velneshwar Beach: 15 Kms

The picturesque coastline of Velneshwar is extremely wonderful. The coastline is popular for its uncommon highlights, for example, the lovely coconut grooves encompassing it and a spotless sea shore with its boisterous, thundering ocean waves. You should see the tall coconut gardens developing on the sickle molded sea shore. The historical backdrop of the Velneshwar Temple is as old as the historical backdrop of the town as well. The side of the Velneshwar Temple which is lowered in the ocean is known as the 'Merumandal'.



Hedavi Mandir: 15 Kms

Hedvi village is popular for the Lord Ganesh Temple also known as Hedvi Ganesh Temple And the Sri Dasabhuj Lakshmi Ganesh Temple. The name Sri Dasabhuj Lakshmi Ganesh Temple is derived from the idol of Lord Ganesh which possesses dash-bhuja, (Ten Hands). The Temple territory is exceptionally delightful and there are steps paving the way to the Temple. A street for vehicles has likewise been developed to arrive at the top. Visitors begin to look all starry eyed at the vivid bastion and the mango groove encompassing the territory. Visitors fall in love with the colorful bastion and the mango groove surrounding the area of Hedvi Ganesh Temple.



Baman Ghal &: 15 Kms

Baman Ghal is an uncommon characteristic marvel where continuos gradation of the rocks by the ocean has made a gorge in the black rock patch around 15 feet deep and about 4 feet wide. Baman Ghal is situated on Hedvi sea shore & is very close to the well known Hedvi Ganesh Temple & Umamaheshwar Temple. "Ghal" in marathi (the local language of the spot) truly implies as gorge.





Guhagar, a quaint town in Konkan which is honored with rustic and historic vacation destinations where Gopalgad Hill remains one of the most important. The slope is one of the most beautiful places in Anjanvel town of Guhagar. It is better known for the notable Gopalgad Fort, which goes back its reality to some place around sixteenth century. Built by Bijapur Rulers and later vanquished by Shivaji in 1660, the post stood high points and low points of time at a huge level. Today the fortress delights guests with its old glorious dividers and the circumscribing hazy slopes and moving green valleys leave them spellbound and rejuvenated. Luckily, Gopalgad Fort saw the beginning of India's freedom when the British left their power over it and made a trip back to their local land. The legacy of Gopalgad Hill is squashed with its encompassing characteristic tastefulness that make a pure setting to an apathetic yet thrilling occasion.



Dabhol Creek Boating: 30 Kms

Dabhol Creek Ferry Boat is the closest method to reach Dapoli from Guhagar. Dabhol Dhopave venture goes on for around 20 minutes over the Vashishti River. The ferry boat carries vehicles, bikes, and so on alongside travelers over the River Vashishthi waterway which streams from Chiplun & joins the Arabian Sea at Dabhol Creek. It has a little dark sand sea shore & is also acclaimed for Dabhol Power Venture Chandika Mandir is a well-known sanctuary in Dabhol. Here you can also enjoy ship vessels that take you to the remote Arabian Sea for Dolphin viewing.



Chandika Temple : 34 Kms

The Chandika Devi temple is dedicated to the Hindu goddess Chandika Mai also known as Kali. It is located in a very beautiful place where many people visit to seek divine intervention and blessings. The temple is located inside the cave and it is considered sacred among the locals. This is one of the attractions for the town. It is said that the idol of Chandika goddess is formed naturally i.e. Swayambhu. Visitors are not allowed to carry any kind of light torch, flashlight, etc. Only oil lamps are allowed inside. There is also a live spring of fresh water. The inside beauty and ambience of the Chandika temple is fascinating.
